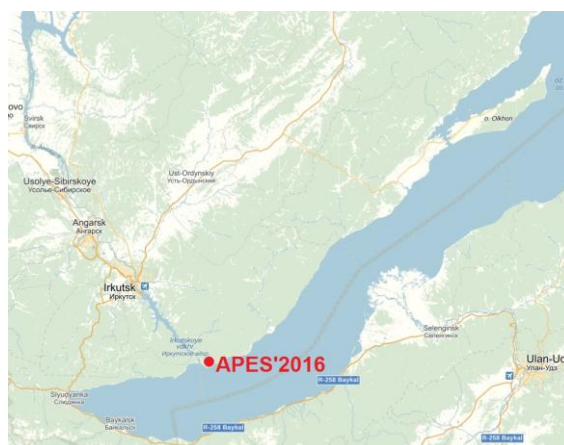

Venue

The Symposium will be held in Mayak Hotel, Listvyanka, on the shore of Lake Baikal near Irkutsk city, Russia. The Hotel provides various types of comfortable rooms. The conference hall of Mayak Hotel is ready to welcome up to 160 guests, and all scientific sessions will be held there.

The closest big city to the conference venue is Irkutsk (~60 km away). Its international airport can be reached from many places within Russia and abroad including daily direct domestic flights from international hubs Moscow and Novosibirsk (Russia), Vladivostok (Russia Far East) and also by several direct international flights from Beijing, Hong-Kong (China), Seoul (Korea).
