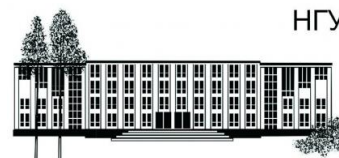

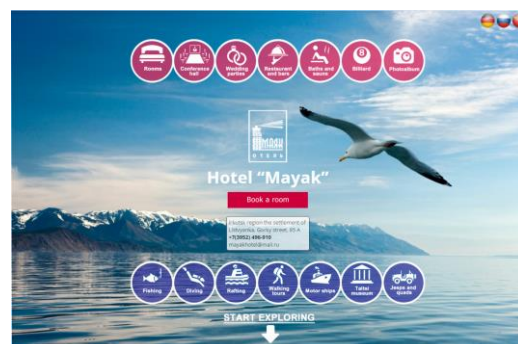

Visa

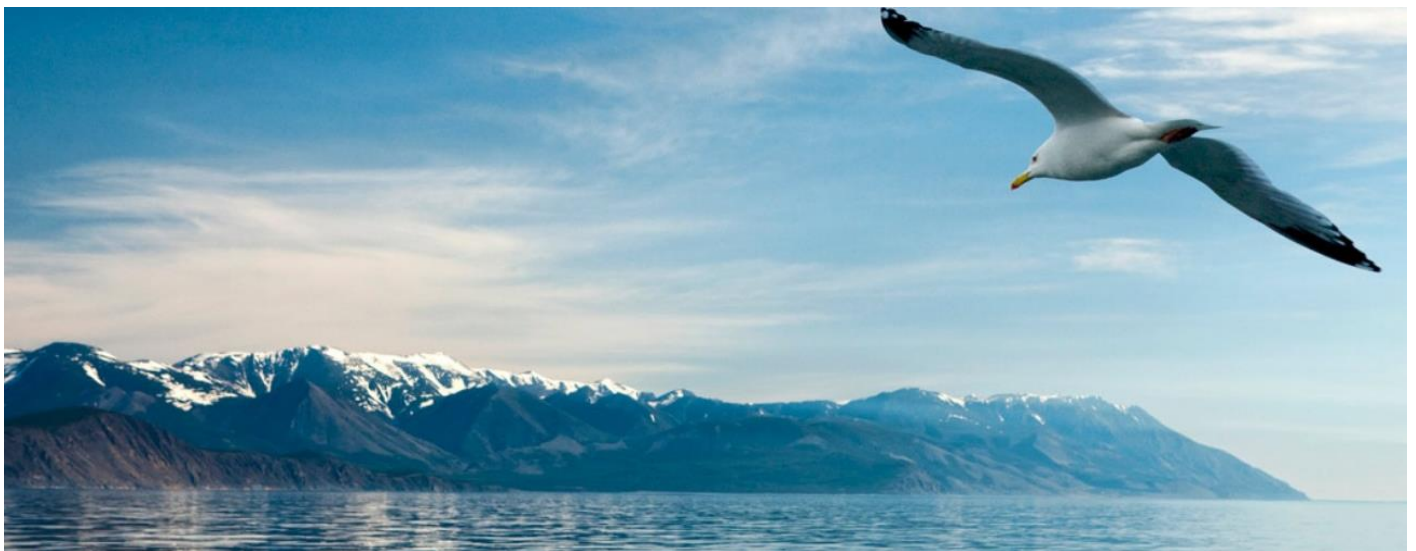
