I am writing to you as a follow up to the 2023 meetings of the Conferences of the Parties to the Basel, Rotterdam and Stockholm Conventions held in Geneva, Switzerland, from 1 May to 12 May 2023, during which the eleventh meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Stockholm Convention undertook the evaluation of the performance and sustainability of all the regional centres, including the Regional Centre for Capacity-building and the Transfer of Technology, Russian Federation (SCRC-Russian Federation).
